11th Annual Calgary Music Collectors Show Tops 100 Vendors for Spring Sale

Rare and obscure progressive rock, punk, soul, new wave and more to headline sale

Calgary, AB – The 11th annual Calgary Music Collectors Show returns **Sunday, May 5, 2019**, at **Acadia Recreation Centre (240 90 Ave SE)** from **11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**, with **early access offered – at additional cost – between 9:30 and 11:00 a.m.** The semi-annual spring show consistently features one of the largest selections of new and used music, collectibles and music memorabilia in western Canada. The 11th spring show will welcome more than 100 vendors providing a wide array of music on vinyl, compact disc and cassette tape, as well as music memorabilia and collectibles, vintage Hi-Fi equipment, and more.

The spring 2019 show will welcome vendors from across Alberta – and beyond – including: Daaren Boreham, specializing in soul and new wave, mod revival and punk; Tom Misco, an avid collector of progressive and German rock who will bring more than 400 imported albums and obscure CDs to the show; Chris Walters, from Edmonton, who brings a broad collection of affordably-priced '70s and '80s rock; and Mike Molly, a Lethbridge-based collector of psych rock, lo-fi and contemporary indie music.

Regular admission **between 11:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. is just \$5 per person and free for children 12 and under.** Eager audiophiles can take advantage of **priority admission during the *First Choice Collectors Hour* between 9:30 and 11:00 a.m., for \$10 per person.**
