Calgary Music Collectors Spring 2018 Show Celebrates 10 Years

Local show welcomes 70 vendors with vinyl, vintage Hi-Fi equipment, collectibles, and more

Calgary, AB – The Calgary Music Collectors Show returns for its tenth season on **Sunday, May 6, 2018**, at **Acadia Recreation Centre (240 90 Ave SE)** from **11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**, with early access offered – at **additional cost – between 9:30 and 11:00 a.m.** The semi-annual event is one of the largest gatherings of new and used music, collectibles and related memorabilia in western Canada, drawing music enthusiasts from across Alberta and beyond. The annual spring boasts even more vendors than in the fall, with more than 70 merchants at 100 tables offering a broad selection of music on vinyl, compact disc and cassette tapes, as well as music memorabilia and collectibles, vintage Hi-Fi equipment, and more. The annual spring show typically draws 600 to 800 attendees each year.

Regular admission **between 11:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. is just \$5 per person and free for children 12 and under.** Eager audiophiles can access the sale even earlier this year with **priority admission between 9:30 and 11:00 a.m., for \$10 per person.**

In addition to many returning favorites, a number of new vendors and personal collectors join the May show for the first time. New entries to the spring Calgary Music Collectors Show include: Garfield 'That Kamloops Record Guy', who specializes in jazz, RnB, and classic rock; vendor Jon Lyne, who will come stocked with a wide variety of musical styles and genres; and Christ Boulter of the Calgary-based online vinyl retailer, [Surface Noiz](#).

"2018 marks the tenth anniversary of the Calgary Music Collectors Show, and with each passing year, each passing show, I'm still excited to be part of this community," says Mark Corner, founder and organizer of the Calgary Music Collectors Show. "I'd encourage anyone who's been curious about getting into record collecting to come down, talk to vendors, ask questions and get to know the community – it's an incredibly welcoming environment full of people who love music and are eager to share that passion with others."

The spring 2018 Calgary Music Collectors Show takes place **Sunday, May 6** at **Acadia Recreation Centre (240 90 Ave SE)** from **11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.**, with early access offered between 9:30 and 11:00 a.m. at additional cost. Regular admission between 11:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. is just \$5 and free for those 12 and under.
